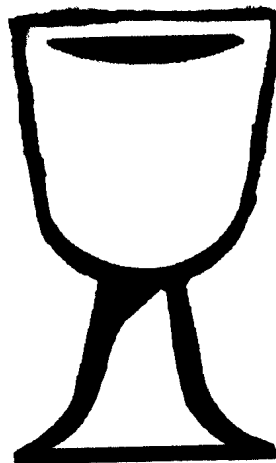
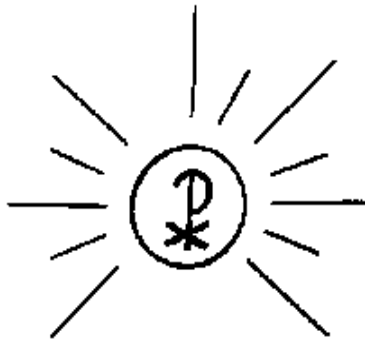

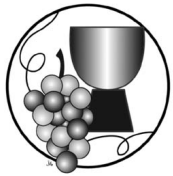

Follow-Up to  
Your Child's  
First Eucharist (Communion)



The preparation is over and your child has now joined you at the Eucharistic table. So that your child's First Communion does not become a memory of a once-only past event, you might find these suggestions helpful:

- ✚ Go as a family to Mass each Sunday. Make sure your child can see, hear and actively celebrate. As a family, participate in the life of the parish.
- ✚ Meal times are especially key to fostering the sense of being a "Eucharistic people". Say grace at meals. Let your home and table be places where all are welcome and included. Special family occasions should be celebrated around the table with extended family members and friends.
- ✚ Eucharist = thanksgiving. Encourage your children to be thankful for all they have and to be aware of those less fortunate than themselves.
- ✚ Encourage your child to be faithful to prayer. Share in his/her bedtime prayers.
- ✚ By your example let your child experience what it means to be "bread for others" - to be the body of Christ in the world - through your day-to-day family living, your friendships, your kindness and service to others.



## June 7, 2015 Solemnity of the Body & Blood of Christ

The people in the first reading wanted to obey the Lord. Moses sealed this with the covenant of blood between the Lord and his people. In the second reading, we hear that the blood of Christ obtained eternal redemption for human-kind. Jesus reminds us of this in the Gospel as he celebrates the Passover with his disciples. Jesus was obedient to the Father, and suffered death on the cross. But before he did this, Jesus established and sealed the New Covenant. The Lord shed his blood for us so that we could have hope of eternal redemption. During the Last Supper, Christ spoke of the blood of the covenant. We are reminded of this covenant every time we gather to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

## NEW DIOCESAN POLICY MASS STIPENDS

A recent directive has been received from the Diocesan Office indicating that Mass Stipends are increased to \$15 per Mass effective February 2, 2015. All masses after that date will be increased from \$10 to the new stipend of \$15 per Mass. Mass stipends will now receive a tax receipt.
