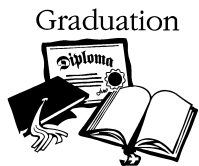

**Day of Prayer for the III Extraordinary General
Assembly of the Synod of Bishops**

On September 28, the Holy Father asks that the whole Church pray for the Third Extraordinary Assembly of the Synod of Bishops on the pastoral challenges of the family in the context of evangelization, scheduled to take place from October 5 to 19, 2014. Here is the prayer for the Synod written by Pope Francis:
