As in the past, I will continue to visit at Saint Luke every Wednesday morning. On Thursday mornings, I will visit with students and staff at Saint John XXIII-Corpus Christi, and on Friday mornings, I will be present to do bus duty at Saint Hubert's. The Saint Hubert's

community is a new addition to the timetable, and I will be sharing those visits with Father Trevor Scarfone, the pastor at Holy Name of Jesus. During this past week, we have set dates for liturgical celebrations with the students from each of these three schools; I'm looking forward to the adventures that God has in store for all of us in the coming months.

Preparing for First Reconciliation

A meeting will be held on *Wednesday evening, September 17, 2014* in the parish hall at Saint Peter's church beginning at 7:00pm for parents of all students in grade 3 and higher who would like to celebrate the Sacrament of First Reconciliation with us this year. Catechetical sessions for students preparing to celebrate Reconciliation will be offered on Sunday mornings (Sept 28, Oct 5, October 19, October 26 and Nov 2) after the 9:00am Mass. We will celebrate the Sacrament of First Reconciliation at Saint Peter's on Wednesday evening, November 12, 2014 beginning at 7:00pm.

I will be on retreat with the priests of the diocese from September 22-26, 2014. Please pray for all of us, that we will listen closely to the voice of the Lord during this time of blessing. Also, I have been asked to lead the annual retreat for the deacons of the Nipissing region. This retreat will take place from September 30 to October 2, 2014. Did you know?

Pope Francis has called a special meeting of Bishops and other experts to discuss the pastoral challenges facing the family in the context of evangelization. This meeting, called a Synod, will take place in Rome from October 5-19, 2014. In preparation for this Synod, consultations were conducted with people all over the world. Even we at Saint Peter's had a chance to submit our reflections. These consultations were condensed into a <u>working document</u> which will form the basis of next month's discussions.
