### Sixth Sunday of Easter

*"The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, will... remind you of all that I told you."*  
John 14

The first gift of every Christian existence is the Holy Spirit.

*"All the spiritual work within us towards God is performed by the Holy Spirit, this gift. He works within us to carry forward our Christian life towards the Father, with Jesus. The first task of Christians is precisely to keep alive this flame that Jesus brought to the earth (see Lk 12:49), and what is this flame? It is love, the Love of God, the Holy Spirit.*

*"Come, come Holy Spirit, warm my heart. Come and teach me to pray, teach me to look to the Father, to look to the Son. Teach me the path of faith. Teach me how to love and, above all, teach me to have an attitude of hope".*

*Let us not forget, the Spirit is present, he is present in us. Let us listen to the Spirit, let us call to the Spirit - he is the gift, the present that God has given us - and say to him: "Holy Spirit, I do not know your face - we do not know it - but I know that you are the strength, that you are the light, that you are able to make me go forth, and to teach me how to pray.
