

The Epiphany of the Lord

" On entering the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother; and they knelt down and paid him homage."

Matthew 2:1-12 The star appearing in the sky kindled in their minds and in their hearts a light that moved them to seek the great Light of Christ.

"This is life: Christian life is a journey, but being attentive, tireless and courageous. A Christian journeys like this. *Journey attentively, tirelessly, courageously. The* experience of the Magi evokes the journey of every man and woman towards Christ.

To seek God means to journey - focused on the sky and discerning in the visible sign of the star the invisible God who speaks to our hearts. The star that is able to lead every man to Jesus is the Word of God, the Word that is in the Bible, in the Gospels.
