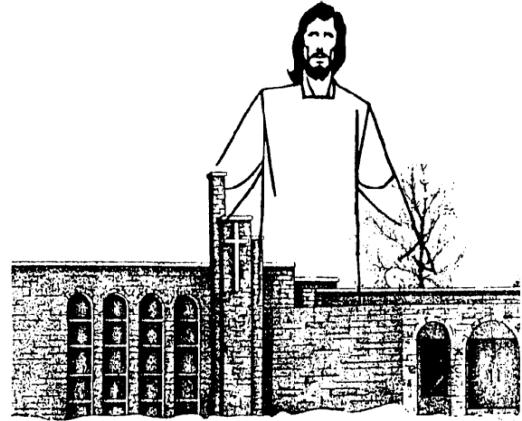

### Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

When Jesus noticed how the dinner guests chose the places of honor, he told them a parable. Luke 14:7

Jesus does not intend to give rules of social behaviour, but rather a lesson on the value of humility.



“Jesus helps us to understand the necessity of choosing the last place, that is, of seeking to be small and

hidden: humility. When we place ourselves before God in this dimension of humility, God exalts us, he stoops down to us so as to lift us up to Himself; “For every one who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.” (v. 11).

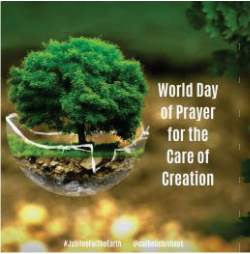
