Marriage


Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

The Ascension of the Lord



"As the disciples were watching, Jesus was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight." Acts 1:9

Today is the Solemnity of the Assumption.

Our gaze is directed towards Heaven, where the glorified Jesus is seated at the right hand of God (cf. Mk 16:19).

"The Ascension also reminds us of the mission of the Church. The Lord's Ascension into Heaven, while inaugurating a new form of Jesus' presence among us, calls us to keep eyes and hearts open to encounter Him, to serve Him and bear witness to Him to others.
