Marriage

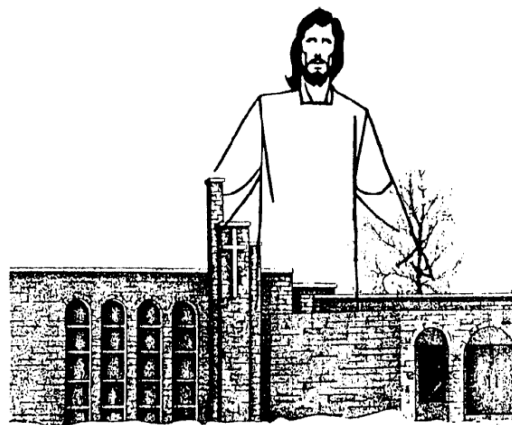
Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

SUNDAY, JUNE 11, 2023

Corpus Christi

“The Lord your God ... fed you with manna, which you did not know” (Dt 8:2-3). The command of Moses is to return to the basics, to the experience of total dependence on God.

“Besides physical hunger, man experiences another hunger, a hunger that cannot be satiated with ordinary food. It’s a hunger for life, a hunger for love, a hunger for eternity. And the sign of manna - it was the symbol of a food that satisfies this deep human hunger. Jesus gives us this food, rather, He himself is the living bread that gives life to the world (cf. Jn 6:51). The Eucharist communicates the Lord’s love for us: a love so great that it nourishes us with Himself - a freely given love, always available to every person who hungers and needs to regenerate his/her own strength. To live the experience of faith means to allow oneself to be nourished by the Lord and to build one’s own existence not with material goods but with the reality that does not perish: the gifts of God, His Word and His Body.

His Body is the true food in the form of bread; His Blood is the true drink in the form of wine. It isn’t simple nourishment to satisfy the body, like manna; the Body of Christ is the bread of the last times, capable of giving life, eternal life, because this bread is made of love.” June 19, 2014 **Let us ask Our Lady to help us rediscover the beauty of the Eucharist, to make it the centre of our life, especially at Sunday Mass and in adoration.**
