Marriage

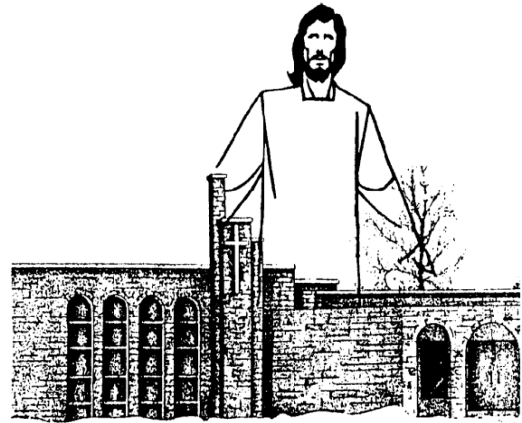
Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

Solemnity of Christ the King

Then one of the criminals said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." Luke 23:42

"What does love ask of me, where is it urging me to go? What answer am I giving Jesus with my life?"

"We joyfully share the splendour of having Jesus as our King: His rule of love transforms sin into grace, death into resurrection, fear into trust.



It would mean very little, however, if we believed Jesus was King of the universe, but did not make him Lord of our lives...

The thief, simply looking at Jesus, believed in His kingdom. He was not closed in on himself, but rather – with his errors, his sins and his troubles – he turned to Jesus. As soon as we give God the chance, He remembers us. God has no memory of sin, but only of us, of each of us, we who are His beloved children. And He believes that it is always possible to start anew, to raise ourselves up. Let us ask for the grace of never closing the doors of reconciliation and pardon, but rather of knowing how to go beyond evil and differences, opening every possible pathway of hope. May our Blessed Lady accompany us, she who was also close to the Cross – our Mother of Mercy.

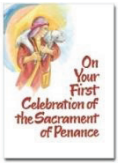
