Marriage

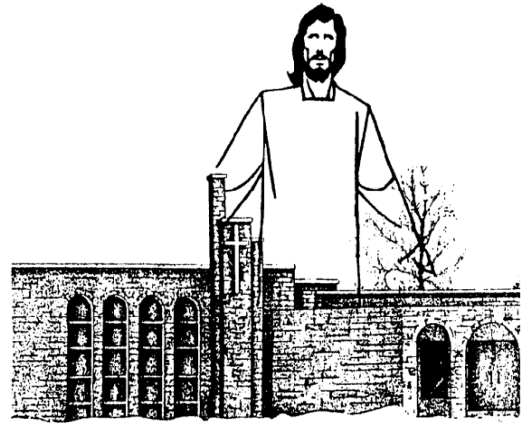
Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

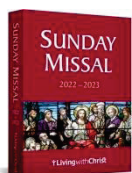

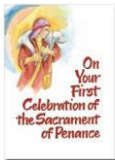
"Jesus' words are perennially relevant, even for us today living in the 21st century, too."

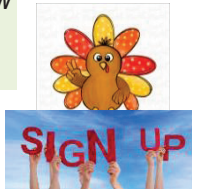

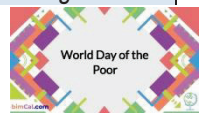

World Day of the Poor – Nov. 13, 2022

"For Your Sakes Christ Became Poor." In a message for this year's observance, the Pope draws on the words of Apostle Paul to the first Christians in Corinth "so that throughout the world Christian communities can become an ever greater sign of Christ's charity for the least and the most in need."



NEWS (The Poor): On Sunday Nov.13th Pope Francis will celebrate Mass in St. Peter's Basilica including the poor. Afterwards, a hot lunch will be served in the Vatican's Paul VI Hall to 1,300 people living in poverty.

The week leading up to World Day of the Poor, a mobile health clinic has been set up in St. Peter's Square allowing for free health screenings and medical care to those who might not otherwise have access. Services offered: general check-ups, ECGs, blood tests, flu shots, COVID-19 tests, and screening for HIV, Hepatitis C, and Tuberculosis. The Vatican is also giving 5,00 food boxes to parishes around Rome which will be distributed to families in need.
