#### Marriage


Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

#### Fifth Sunday of Easter

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinegrower." John 15:1
With this image He teaches us how to abide with Him, to be united to Him, even though He is not physically present Everyone can be united to Jesus in a new way.

"Jesus is the vine, and through Him — like the sap in the tree — the very love of God, the Holy Spirit is passed to the branches. We are the branches, and through this parable, Jesus wants us to understand the importance of remaining united to Him. When one is intimately united to Jesus, one enjoys the gifts of the Holy Spirit, which are — as St Paul tells us — "love, joy, peace, patience,"



kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control" (Gal 5:22). One is recognized as a true Christian by this attitude, as a tree is recognized by its fruit. The

fruits of this profound union with Christ are wonderful: our whole person is transformed by the grace of the Spirit: soul, understanding, will, affections, and even body, because we are united body and soul.

The life of Christ becomes our own: we are able to think like Him, to act like Him, to see the world and the things

like Him, to act like Him, to see the world and the things in it with the eyes of Jesus. And so we are able to love our brothers/sisters, beginning with the poorest and those who suffer the most, as He did and love them with His heart, and so bear fruits of goodness, of charity, and of peace in the world." 
