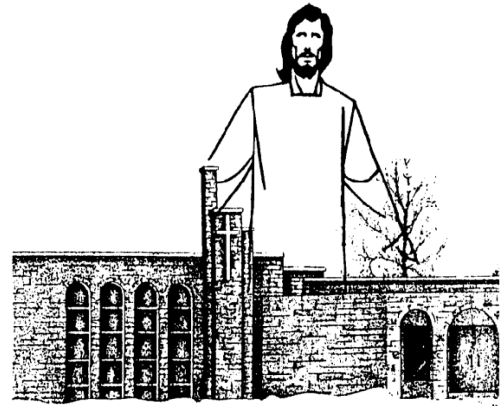

Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” Mark 10:43

To listen, to be a neighbour, to bear witness.

“The journey of faith in today’s Gospel ends in a beautiful and surprising way when Jesus says “Go; your faith has made you well” (v. 52). Yet Bartimaeus had made



no profession of faith or done any good work; he had only begged for mercy.

To feel oneself in need of salvation is the beginning of faith. It is the direct path to encountering Jesus.

The faith that saved Bartimaeus did not have to do with his having clear ideas about God, but in his seeking Him and longing to encounter Him. Faith has to do with encounter, not theory. In encounter, Jesus passes by; in encounter, the heart of the Church beats. Then, not our preaching, but our witness of life will prove effective.” Oct 28, 2018

May the Lord bless our steps, so that we can listen to young people, be their neighbours, and bear witness before them to Jesus, the joy of our lives.

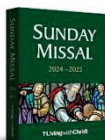
