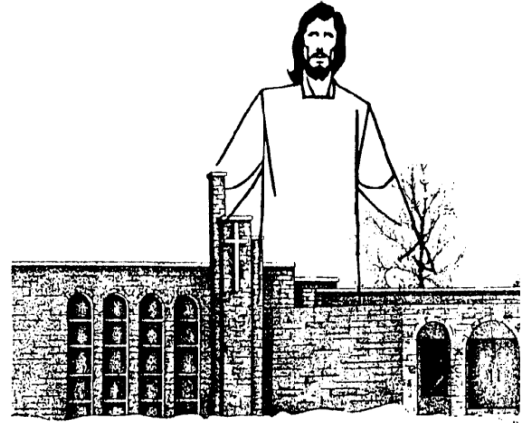

The Lord says, "As a mother comforts her child, so I will comfort you." Isaiah 66:1,13

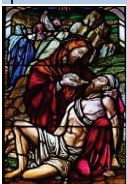

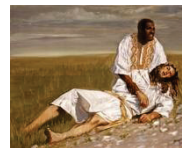

## Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The man asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" Luke 10:29

"Who is my neighbour? Are you Christian? "



"I urge everyone, "laymen and pastors", to ask ourselves if we are Christians open to what the Lord gives us every day, to the surprises of God

that often, like this Samaritan, makes things difficult for us, or are we a Christian official, doing what we have to, feeling that we abide by "the rules" and then being constrained by the same rules? Some ancient theologians, said that in this passage "the whole Gospel" is contained. Each of us is the man there, wounded, and the Samaritan is Jesus. And He healed our wounds. He drew near to us. He took care of us. He paid for us. And He said to his Church: "But if you need more, you pay, I will come back and I will pay". Think about this: in this passage there is the whole Gospel."
