





pilgrimage in the Catholic Church. As part of preparations for the Jubilee 2025, Pope Francis has Pope Francis announced a "Year of Prayer" ahead of the upcoming Jubilee, and invites the faithful to pray for Christian unity and for peace throughout the world.
