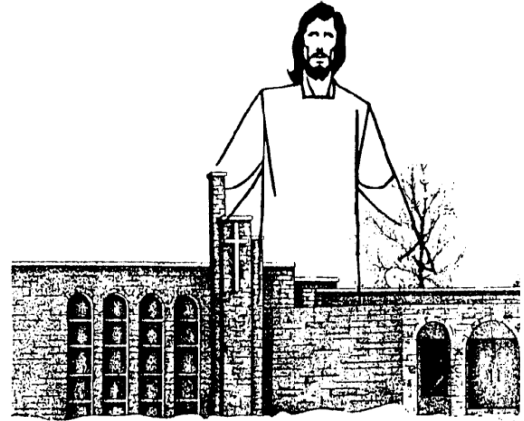

Duties and Responsibilities include:

- Vacuuming and cleaning of carpet and hard flooring
- Management of waste and supplies
- Use of machinery such as lawn equipment and floor cleaning equipment
- Clearing of snow at the building entrance, rectory, and pathways
- Disinfection of surfaces within the building
- Minor building repairs
- Preparation and post cleaning for special Parish gatherings and events as required
- General overall weekly cleaning of Church & grounds
- Seasonal maintenance of water lines, and boiler, etc
- Maintain stores and supply of staples for bathrooms, kitchen, Church and sacristy
