## Marriage

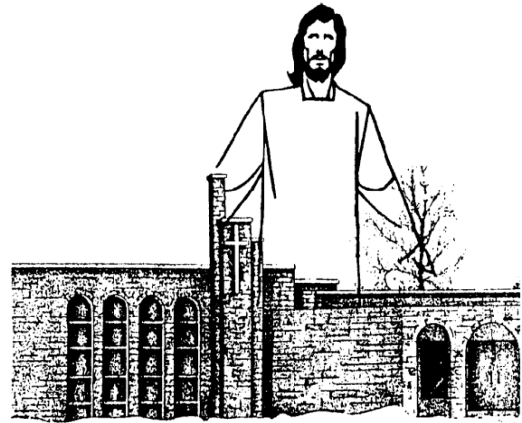
Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

### Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus said, "Now God is God not of the dead, but of the living; for to God all of them are alive." Luke 20:38

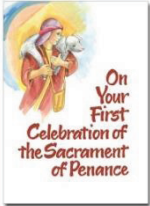

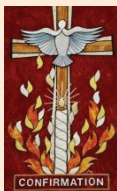

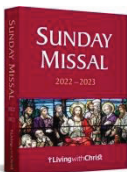
