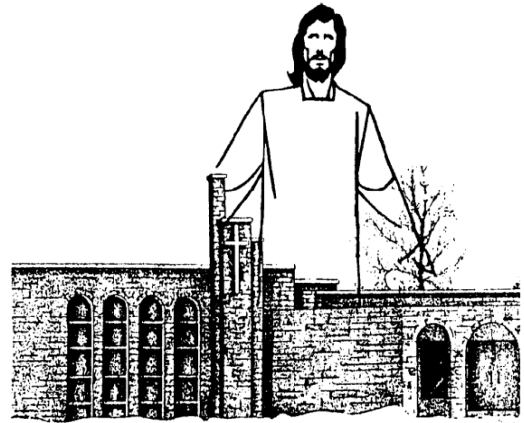

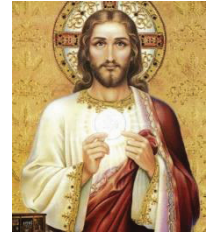

"The Lord comes to our streets in order to speak a blessing for us and to give us courage. And He asks that, we too, be a blessing and gift for others."

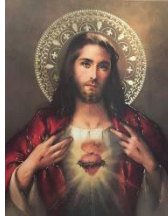
World Day of Prayer for Priests June 24, 2022
