

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Everyone spoke well of Jesus and were amazed at the gracious words that came from his mouth." Luke 4:22

"God wants faith... they want miracles, signs; God wants to save everyone ...and they want a Messiah for their own benefit."
