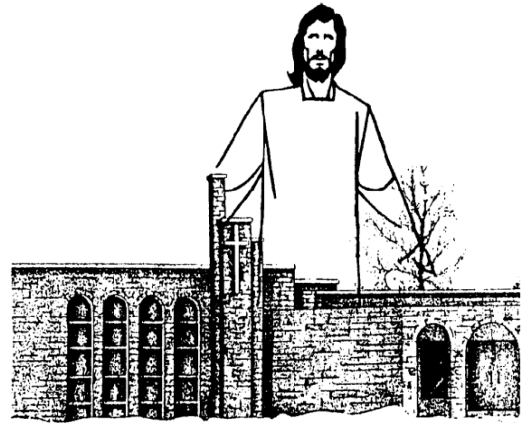

### Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

*“Everyone spoke well of Jesus and were amazed at the gracious words that came from his mouth.” Luke 4:22*

“God wants faith... they want miracles, signs; God wants to save everyone ... and they want a Messiah for their own benefit.”

*“Jesus, in living the mission entrusted to him by the Father, knows well that he must face fatigue, rejection, persecution and defeat. A price that, yesterday as today, authentic prophecy is called to pay. The harsh rejection, however, does not discourage Jesus, nor does it stop the journey and the fruitfulness of his prophetic action. He goes ahead on his way (cf. v. 30), trusting in the Father’s love.*

*“Today too, the world needs to see prophets in the Lord’s disciples, that is, people who are courageous and persevere in responding to the Christian vocation. People who follow the “drive” of the Holy Spirit, who sends them to proclaim hope and salvation to the poor and the excluded; ...people dedicated to the service of all, without privileges and exclusion. In short: people who are ready to welcome the Father’s will within them and undertake to witness to it faithfully to others.*

In 1997, Pope Saint John Paul II instituted this global

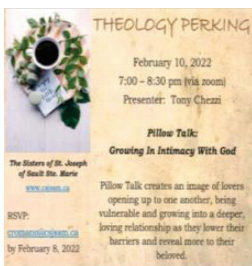
