

"John the Baptist's invitation resounds:

"Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" (Mt 3:2)."

"The good news that Jesus brings us - and that John predicts - is that we do not need to wait for the kingdom of God in the future: it is at hand. God comes to establish His lordship in our lives; and there - where it is welcomed with faith and humility - love, joy and peace blossom.




