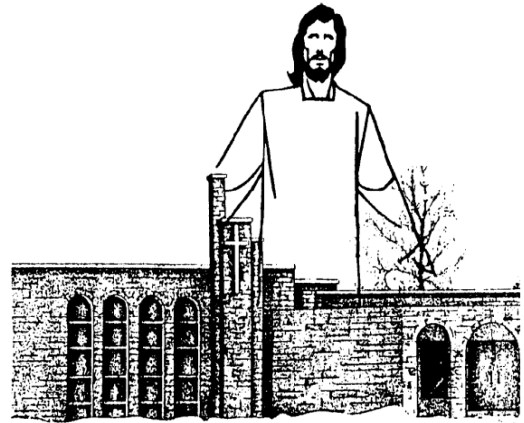

“The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He has anointed me to bring good news to the poor.” Luke 4:18

“To accept littleness... means embracing Jesus in the little ones of today. Loving Him, that is, in the least of our brothers and sisters.”

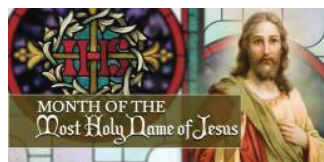
