Third Sunday of Advent

"Jesus answered them, "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have good news brought to them." Matt 11:4-5



"To the prophet Isaiah's explicit invitation to joy: "The desert and the parched land will exult, the steppe will rejoice and bloom" (35:1)...The Gospel contrasts with John the Baptist"

"Jesus looks beyond. The Holy Spirit makes His heart feel the power of His promise, and He announces salvation: "Courage, do not fear! Here is your God. He comes to save you" (v. 4). And then everything is transformed: the desert blooms, consolation and joy take hold of the lost heart, the lame, the blind, those who can't speak are healed (cf. vv. 5-6). Like John, we, too, are called to recognize the face that God has chosen to take in Jesus Christ - humble and merciful.

Advent is a time of grace. It tells us that it is not enough to believe in God: it is necessary every day to purify our faith. The Child lying in the crib has the face of our most needy brothers and sisters, of the poor who "are the privileged ones of this mystery and, often, those who are the most able to recognize the presence of God among us" Dec.15,2019

May the Virgin Mary helps us, so that, as we approach Christmas, we do not allow ourselves to be distracted by the external things, but we make room in our hearts for the One who has already come and wants to come again to heal our illnesses and to give us His joy.
