Marriage


Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

The compassion of Jesus...

"The Gospel says that Jesus, seeing the leper, was moved with compassion, tenderness. Three words

that indicate God's style: nearness, compassion, tenderness.

To respect the rules regarding good reputation and social customs, we often silence pain or we wear masks that camouflage it. To balance the calculations of our selfishness and the interior laws of our fears we do not get that involved with the sufferings of others. Instead, let us ask the Lord for the grace to live these two "transgressions" from today's Gospel: that of the leper, so that we might have the courage to emerge from our isolation and, instead of staying put and feeling sorry for ourselves or crying over our failings, complaining, and instead of this, let us go to Jesus just as we are; "Jesus I am like this". We will feel that embrace, that embrace of Jesus that is so beautiful.

And then Jesus's transgression, a love that goes beyond conventions, that overcomes prejudices and the fear of getting involved with the lives of others. Let us learn to be transgressors like these two: like the leper and like Jesus." Feb.14, 2021

May the Virgin Mary accompany us on this journey.
