Marriage

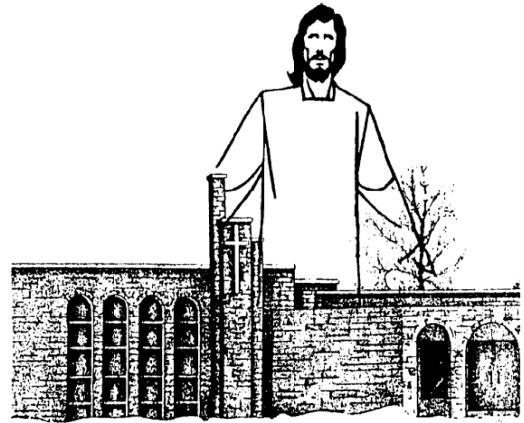
Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“He also told a parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous and regarded others with contempt. “ Luke 18:9

The word of God today helps us to pray.

“The prayer of the tax collector is the prayer of the poor man, a prayer pleasing to God. It is a prayer which, as the first reading says, “will reach to the clouds” (Sir 35:20), unlike the prayer of the Pharisee, which is weighed down by vanity.

Families need God: all of us! We need His help, His strength, His blessing, His mercy, His forgiveness. And we need simplicity to pray as a family. It is a matter of humility, of realizing that we need God, like the tax collector.

How do we keep our faith as a family? Are we able to share it by our witness, by our acceptance of others, by our openness? Christian families are missionary families. They are missionary in their everyday lives as they bring to everything the salt and the leaven of faith.

Is there joy in your family? True joy which we experience in the family is not superficial. The basis of this feeling of deep joy is the presence of God, the presence of God in the family and His love, which is welcoming, merciful, and respectful towards all.

And above all, a love which is patient.

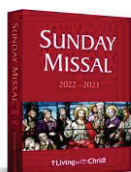

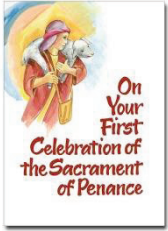
