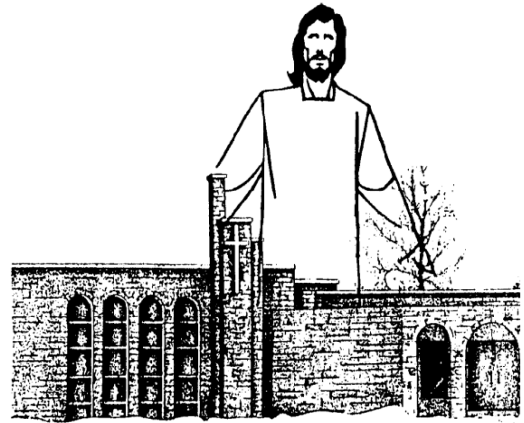

The Ascension of the Lord

"While He was blessing them, He withdrew from them and was carried up into Heaven." Luke 24:44-53
