#### Marriage


Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

## **SUNDAY, JUNE 25, 2023**

Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Fear no one; for nothing is covered up that will not be uncovered..." (Matt 10:26-27). The invitation Jesus addresses to His disciples resonates: to have no fear, to be strong and confident in the face of life's challenges...

"Jesus forewarns them of the adversities that await them. Today's passage is part of the missionary discourse, with which the Teacher prepares the Apostles for their first experience of proclaiming the Kingdom of God. Jesus persistently exhorts them "not to be afraid", "do not be afraid", and Jesus describes three situations that they will find themselves facing.

The only fear that a disciple should have is to lose this divine gift, this closeness and friendship with God - to stop living according to the Gospel, thereby experiencing moral death, which is the effect of sin. Jesus exhorts them not to fear, because even while experiencing these and other pitfalls, the lives of the disciples rest firmly in the hands of God, who loves us and looks after us. At times one feels this spiritual aridness. We must not be afraid of it. The Father takes care of us, because we are greatly valued in His eyes. What is important is the frankness, the courage of our witness, of our witness of faith: "recognizing Jesus before others" and continuing to do

good." June21,2020 May Mary Most Holy, model of trust and abandonment in God in the hour of adversity and danger, help us never to surrender to despair, but rather always to entrust ourselves to Him and to His grace, since the grace of God is always more powerful than evil.



We pray that Canadians may seek to be witnesses to Christ in Canada and the world, and continue to work to influence those in government to

act with Christian principles and attitudes.

May all God's people share in the goods of this Earth.



#### The Solemnity of St Peter and St Paul - June 29, 2021

The Church credits a part of its greatness to St Peter and St Paul who under God's guidance helped found the capital of the Chrisitian Empire; especially since they were martyred in Rome.

St Peter was martyred under Nero, in A.D. 66 or 67 and is buried on the hill of the

Vatican. Recent excavations have revealed his tomb on the very site of the Basilica of St. Peter's. Millions have made a pilgrimage to the tombs of both St Peter and St Paul. A partial indulgence may be gained today by anyone who makes devout use of a religious article of devotion blessed by a priest provided they also make a profession of faith (Apostles Creed).

O holy Apostles, Peter and Paul, I choose you this day and forever to be my special patrons and advocates; thee, Saint Peter, Prince of the Apostles, because thou art the Rock, upon which Almighty God hath built His Church; thee, Saint Paul, because thou was fore-chosen by God as the Vessel of election and the Preacher of truth in the whole

Obtain for me, I pray you, lively faith, firm hope, and burning love; complete detachment from myself, contempt of the world, patience in adversity, humility in prosperity, attention in prayer, purity of heart, a right intention in all my works, diligence in fulfilling the duties of my state of life, constancy in my resolutions, resignation to the will of God and perseverance in the grace of God even unto death; that so, by means of your intercession and your glorious merits, I may be able to overcome the temptations of the world, the flesh and the devil, and may be made worthy to appear before the chief and eternal Shepherd of souls, Jesus Christ, Who with the Father and the Holy Spirit lives and reigns for endless ages, to enjoy His presence and love Him forever. Amen.
