Marriage

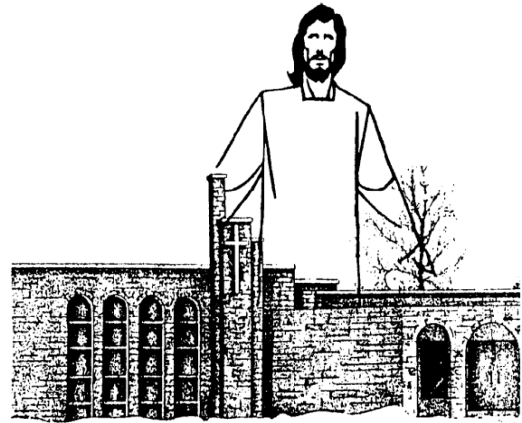
Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"You cannot serve God and wealth." Luke 16:13

Today, Jesus invites us to reflect on two opposing ways of life: the way of the world and that of the Gospel. "The spirit of the Gospel requires a serious lifestyle – serious but joyful, full of joy! – serious and challenging, marked by honesty, fairness, respect for others and their dignity, and a sense of duty. And this is Christian astuteness! The journey of life necessarily involves a choice between two roads: between honesty and dishonesty, between fidelity and infidelity, between selfishness and altruism, between good and evil. You can not waver between one and the other, because they move on different and conflicting forms of logic. The prophet Elijah said to the people of Israel that went on these two roads: "You are limping with both feet!" (cf. 1 Kings 18:21). It is important to decide which direction to take and then, once you have chosen the right one, to walk it with enthusiasm and determination, trusting in God's grace and the support of His Spirit. In gratuitousness and by giving of ourselves to our brothers and sisters, we serve the right master: God." Sept 18, 2016
