
Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

The Most Holy Trinity

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." Matt 28:19-20

The Most Holy Trinity - one God in three

Persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. "The Trinity is the communion of Divine Persons who are one with the others, one for the others, one in the others: this communion is the life of God, the mystery of the love of the Living God. Jesus revealed this mystery to us.

Jesus sent the disciples to evangelize to the peoples, He told them to baptize them "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Mt 28:19). His command is entrusted by Christ in all ages to the Church, which has inherited the missionary mandate from the Apostles. He also directs it to each one of us who, through the power of Baptism, are part of His Community. We are called to live as one with others, for others, and in others. 
