

SUNDAY, JUNE 23, 2024

Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time "Teacher, do you not care if we perish?" Mark 4:37 And quite often we, too, beaten by the trials of life, have cried out to the Lord: "Why do you remain silent and do nothing for me?"

"There are many moments in which we feel we are in a storm; we feel we are almost done in.

To be disciples of Jesus it is not enough to believe God is there, that He exists, but we must put ourselves out there with Him; we must also raise our voice with Him. Listen to this: we must cry out to Him. Prayer, many times, is a cry: "Lord, save me!"

Today we can ask ourselves: what are the winds that beat against my life? What are the waves that hinder my navigation, and put my spiritual life, my family life, even my mental health in danger? Let us say all this to Jesus; let us tell Him everything. He wants this; He wants us to grab hold of Him to find shelter from the unexpected waves of life.

We need Jesus like sailors need the stars to find their course. Faith begins from believing that we are not enough in ourselves, from feeling in need of God. When we overcome the temptation to close ourselves off, when we overcome the false religiosity that does not want to disturb God, when we cry out to Him, He can work wonders in us. It is the gentle and extraordinary power of prayer, which works miracles." June20, 2021

The Solemnity of St Peter and St Paul - June 29, 2021

The Church credits a part of its greatness to St Peter and St Paul who under God's guidance helped found the capital of the Chrisitian Empire; especially since they were martyred in Rome.

St Peter was martyred under Nero, in A.D. 66 or 67 and is buried on the hill of the

Vatican. Recent excavations have revealed his tomb on the very site of the Basilica of St. Peter's. Millions have made a pilgrimage to the tombs of both St Peter and St Paul. A partial indulgence may be gained today by anyone who makes devout use of a religious article of devotion blessed by a priest provided they also make a profession of faith (Apostles Creed).

O holy Apostles, Peter and Paul, I choose you this day and forever to be my special patrons and advocates; thee, Saint Peter, Prince of the Apostles, because thou art the Rock, upon which Almighty God hath built His Church; thee, Saint Paul, because thou was fore-chosen by God as the Vessel of election and the Preacher of truth in the whole

Obtain for me, I pray you, lively faith, firm hope, and burning love; complete detachment from myself, contempt of the world, patience in adversity, humility in prosperity, attention in prayer, purity of heart, a right intention in all my works, diligence in fulfilling the duties of my state of life, constancy in my resolutions, resignation to the will of God and perseverance in the grace of God even unto death; that so, by means of your intercession and your glorious merits, I may be able to overcome the temptations of the world, the flesh and the devil, and may be made worthy to appear before the chief and eternal Shepherd of souls, Jesus Christ, Who with the Father and the Holy Spirit lives and reigns for endless ages, to enjoy His presence and love Him forever. 
